Protect our nesting Loggerheads and their hatchlings. Just a few simple things can make the difference in a female loggerhead nesting or returning to the water.

- 1) If you see a turtle on the beach: do not use flash photography**
- 2) If you see a turtle on the beach: do not use a flashlight**
- 3) Keep ocean front lights off and, if at all possible, keep ocean front shades down in the evening.**
- 4) If you must dig holes in the sand during the day: please fill them in before leaving the beach in the afternoon. Turtles and people can be injured by falling in them after dark.**
- 5) If you see a turtle on the beach: please stay away from her and call our beach coordinator, Terry Meyer at 470-2880.**

We appreciate everyone working with us to help protect these endangered turtles.
